### **"WALK AS CHILDREN OF LIGHT"**

"God is light and in Him is no darkness at all." (1 John 1:5).

God is the very personification of "light". Christians are to walk as children of light." (Ephesians 5:8). This means that we are to walk with God as His children. We are not to walk as others walk "In the vanity of their mind, having the understanding darkened." (Ephesians 4:17, 18).

Our happiness in this lifetime and for eternity depends upon our walking with God. "You shall walk in all the ways which the Lord your God has commanded you, that you may live, and that it may be well with you."? (Deuteronomy 5:33).

Thus says the Lord, 'Stand in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and you shall find rest for your souls.' (Jeremiah 6:16).

God's ways are not man's ways. "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither your ways My ways, says the Lord."(Isaiah 55:8). The ways of man lead to death. Proverbs 14:12 declares, "There is a way which seems right unto man, but the end thereof are the ways of death." John the apostle reminds us, "The world passes away, and the lust thereof, but he that does the will of God abides forever." (1 John 2:17).

Walking with God implies agreement. Amos 3:3 asks the rhetorical question: "Can two walk together except they be agreed?" Our will must harmonize with God's will. God is the one to direct the way as we walk along with Him. We should confess as did Jeremiah, "O Lord, I know that the way of man is not in himself; it is not in man that walks to direct his steps." (Jeremiah 10:23).
