  - b. Teach others and they in turn teach others (**2 Tim 2:2**)
  - c. Teach what is commanded (**1 Tim 4:6-11; 1 Tim 6:3**)
  - d. Make known the wisdom of God (**Eph 3:10**)
2. Importance of the Doctrine
  - a. The doctrine of Christ & no other (**2 John 9-11**)
  - b. The Truth (**2 Tim 4:1-4**)
  - c. The Gospel- has the power to Save (**Rom 1:16**)
  - d. We do not preach but condemn any perversion of the Gospel (**Gal 1:6-9**)
3. Results of teaching the Truth
  - a. Become teachers (**Heb 5:12-14**)
  - b. Serve as a faithful part of the body (**Eph 4:11-16**)
  - c. Be able to give answers (**1 Pt 3:15**)
  - d. Aides us in keeping our eyes on Christ (**Heb 12:1-2**)
  - e. The Heavenly reward (**Jn 14:1-3**)
