The Necessities

However, they do have the right to be appreciative. We should remember the attitude of the Israelites in Deuteronomy 8:17 and not be as they were.

The fifth reason to use our talents is that it is our personal responsibility. Just because others may have greater talents in some areas does not release us from the responsibility of doing our part.

The final reason for using our talents is that in using them we perfect them. The idea of use it or lose it holds true: Practice makes perfect. We must use our talents so that we can improve even more and become of even more use to the Lords church.

However, when using our talent or talents, we must use them in the work for the Lords church and not otherwise, for it would be sinful to misuse our talents. We cannot use them to justify other things, just because they might be useful in other areas. If the acts in which we use them are sinful, we must avoid them.

When we want to do things for the Church we must do so with the right attitude, if we fail to do so then we should not bother with "helping". The wrong attitude no matter the talent is useless. Our heart and our attitude must be right in order to do the most good for the Lord's church.
