
**AUSTIN CHURCH OF CHRIST


NEWTON, KANSAS – We were blessed to be with Fred and Dorothy Rhodes, Eric and Holly Richardson, and the other Jasper County brethren on April 29, 30, and May 1. Luvenia conducted a Teacher's Workshop, and I taught class and preached.



THE ISLAND OF JAMAICA – Luvenia and I were scheduled to be in Linstead (St. Catherine) earlier this month for her to teach some ladies' classes and for me to preach in a

Gospel Meeting. Unfortunately, we had to postpone those efforts.

For some months it was in doubt about me being able to go to Jamaica at all; or to Grand Cayman in July and August, due to some problems with my hips and being unable to walk correctly. With some unexpected financial help from a friend, and then getting signed up for Medicare, I was finally able to go to the doctor. Between seeing her, a therapist, and my holistic doctor, things are improving.



My doctor, when viewing the x-rays of my hips noticed a problem with my spleen, which necessitated a CT scan. The scan revealed an aneurysm. She sent me to a specialist which confirmed its presence. He said the aneurysm has been there a long time, based on the calcification that has occurred. It has a 2% risk of rupture over my lifetime. Although that is a low percentage, in order to keep from checking on it all the time, I have decided to have it stented. We have two mission trips back to back this summer, so in August I will have the procedure. It will involve going in the artery, just as a heart stent. These aneurysms are very rare in men. Research shows that activity does not affect these, so the Doctor said to carry on with my regular activities.

It was “music to my ears” when both doctors gave me the OK to go to Jamaica and Cayman (as long as I make sure to not overdo it, but get plenty of rest, according to my primary doctor).
