An Inheritance 1 Pt 1:3-5 By Russell Earl

Thesis: To show how the Christian can have heaven as their home.

Intro: 1. Life on earth is brief and temporary (**James 4:13-14**)

- 2. However, life is not confined to existence on earth only.
- 3. The possibility of having heaven as our home should encourage the Christian to faithfully serve God (2 Tim 4:7)

I. Christians are Heirs of God

- A. One becomes a child of God by a new birth (1 Pt 1:22-23)
- B. God's children are heirs of God (**Rom 8:16-17**)
- C. God is giving unto His children that which they could not give themselves. (1 Pt 4:7).

II. The Character of this Inheritance

- A. It means salvation (1 Pt 1:5)
 - 1. Salvation, or deliverance, from a world of sin, lust, suffering, and even death (**Rev 21:4b**).
 - 2. Salvation, or deliverance, into a position of glory & honor (**Rom 2:7**).
- B. The inheritance will be incorruptible (1 Pt 1:4)
 - 1. In contrast to things of earth which are subject to decay, God's things are incorruptible (1 Pt 1:23)
 - 2. This inheritance will have to do with the incorruptible part of man, his spirit
 - 3. Heaven will be permanent (**Lk 12:33**).
- C. The inheritance will be undefiled
 - 1. In heaven God's children will be separated from a sinful world (**Rev 21:27**).
 - a. Imagine a place where there is not hate, no greed, no backbiting, no slander, no suffering-physical or mental.
 - b. "There is a land that is fairer than day"
- D. This inheritance is reserved in heaven for God's people.
 - 1. Earthly things shall ultimately end (2 Pt 3:10-11)
 - 2. Since the Christian's inheritance is in heaven, it can never be touched, tarnished, or destroyed by earthly things.

III. The Assurance of this Inheritance

- A. Hope based on the resurrection of Christ from the dead (1 Pt 1:3).
 - 1. The resurrection was proof that Jesus was no mere man (**Rom 1:4**)
 - 2. Therefore, what He promises is true and reliable.
- B. The inheritance is "guarded"
 - 1. By God (1 Pt 1:5)
 - 2. By man's faith (1 Pt 1:5)

- C. Add Christian graces and insure inheritance (2 Pt 1:5-11)
 - 1. These graces are practical, man can translate them into practice.
 - 2. The practice of these things (on the part of the Christian) insures him that the inheritance will be his.
