You May Not Know By Jesse Dickison

You may not know that God has never given man the right to choose his own religion. God has always told man how to worship Him and what to do in that worship. He has never given man the right to set that aside and do something else.

People say, "Everyone has right to his own belief." Men make that claim because that is the way they would like for it to be. But God's Word says, "O Lord, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walketh to direct his steps" (Jer. 10:23). God also says, "There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death" (Prov. 14:12; 16:25).

After Jesus had "...by the grace of God...taste[d] of death for every man" (Heb. 2:9), does man have a right to worship any other way instead? Or do those who claim to believe in Christ have a right to believe anything they want to about what He has said? Do men have a right to set aside any command He has given and say they can be saved without it? Do men have a right to build another church and wear another religious name other than that which is found in the New Testament?

You may or may not know that the Scriptures say that the church is the body of Christ (Col. 1:18); that there is but one body (1 Cor. 12:20; Eph. 4:4). How could one say in the face of these verses that man has a right to belong to any church he wants to? That right does NOT come from God! God commanded men to "...Repent...and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ unto the re-mission of your sins..." (Acts 2:38). No man has the right to change what God has said! Think about it.
