THE GREATEST PROBLEM

The greatest day in a person's life is the day he realizes he is lost in sin and needs the salvation that is in Christ Jesus. “For all have sinned, and fall short of the glory of God” (Rom. 3: 23). “Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy that it cannot hear: But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear” (Isa. 59:1-2).

The greatest problem of people is their sins. Those who do not make room for Jesus in their understanding of what their greatest need is, can never get rid of their sins. God's forgiveness of our sins through Christ is our greatest blessing. “...Unto him that loveth us, and loosed us from our sins by his blood” (Rev. 1:5).

Some of the guiltiest are those who recognize Christ and believe His claims, but have lives so crowded with the cares of the world, with business and “the market place,” and with pleasures of a secular nature, that they do not make room for Jesus in their plans and purposes. Some seem to think that their “inn of knowledge” is occupied from cellar to roof, and that they have no room for Jesus. Such an attitude does not prove one is smart--instead such an attitude is a sure sign that its holder is headed down the road to calamity.

Jesus said, “...Take heed, and keep yourselves from all covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth” (Luke 12:15). Think about these things.
