Salvation

Salvation has been brought to all (**Titus 2:11**). But not all have been brought to salvation. A dead man cannot correct past mistakes--only the living can do that. Repentance is God’s gift to the living. The right or wrong of any matter is determined by God’s will and not by ours. There is always the temptation to put our feelings about salvation before the facts about salvation.

Lost! Perhaps the saddest word in all the world. Jesus wept over a lost world and died on the cross to take away its condemnation. There is a danger of people spending their lives on that which goes bankrupt at the grave. God’s grace has appeared to help bring about a change in our lives. God’s grace cannot flow where there is not a willing receiver. Needed change will not take place without a willing individual. Most folks will listen to what they want to hear. Only a few have the courage to listen to the thing that is needed. Even fewer would be willing to financially support someone to bring about their change or conversion. Most would rather support someone to entertain or amuse them. Change does not come easy for any of us.

True gospel preaching is aimed toward changing desire from self-centered to Christ -centered. Paul found the personal needs of people and met them with the gospel of Christ. It is the duty of all Christians to warn, teach, encourage and admonish people concerning salvation. If they ignore you, that is their problem. Yes, people do need compassion, but they also need the truth. Salvation is not easy--it cost the life of the Son of God. And it will cost you your life--if you are to be saved. It is one thing to admit faults and another thing to correct those faults. To feel guilty about sin is one thing, but to truly change is another.
