### **Faith Defined**

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen (Hebrews 11:1)

Faith believes in something that cannot yet be seen.

### **Misunderstandings about Faith**

Some would have you believe faith believes without evidence or proof. However, we can prove God exists –without the Bible!

For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,(Romans 1:20).

This verse tells us yes, you can prove the God of the Bible exists even without using the Bible. Some say faith simply believes God exists. Faith however, in Bible terms also includes obedience. It's true we must acknowledge He exists but we also must obey Him.

*And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him.*  
(Hebrews 5:9).

*Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.*  
(2 Tim 2:15)

(Acts 17:11)
